



Adventure to Iceland Itinerary ~ Sept 1–10th, 2017

Sept 1, 2017 ~ Evening/overnight flight from Boston to Reykjavík, Iceland

Sept 2, 2017 ~ Day 1: Arrival and Reykjavík

A private coach with an English-speaking driver/guide will meet you at Keflavík International Airport. After everyone's arrival, you will start your tour and head towards the western part of Iceland. Areas visited might include: Hvalfjörður, Glymur waterfall, Borgarnes, Hraunfossar, Húsafell.

Overnight [Fosshótel Reykholt](#) or similar, standard rooms. Hotel is currently renovating the rooms, so the photos on the website are old. Will be complete by September

Approximate mileage: 100 miles.

Sept 3, 2017 ~ Day 2: Borgarnes and north-west Iceland

Drive continues due north. Areas visited might include: Grábrók volcanic crater, Víðistaðakirkja, Hvammstangi, Vatnsnes peninsula, with its many historic areas and hikes, Hvítserkur cliffs, Sauðárkrókur village.

Optional activities: Hvammstangi Seal Center, Gauksmýri horse farm visit, wool factory visit, lunch at amazing fish restaurant in Hvammstangi.

Overnight in Sauðárkrókur. [Hótel Tindastóll](#) or similar, standard rooms in annex.

Approximate mileage: 170 miles

Sept 4, 2017 ~ Day 3: North-west and Tröllaskagi peninsula

Explore north of Iceland. Areas visited might include: Akureyri town, Tröllaskagi peninsula, including Siglufjörður village and many more. Whale watching tour is included.

Optional activities: Visit to shark and baccalao (salted, dried cod) family processing plant, Siglufjörður micro-brewery, Siglufjörður History museum, chocolate tasting at a local chocolatier.

Overnight in Sauðárkrókur. [Hótel Tindastóll](#) or similar, standard rooms in annex.

Approximate mileage: 200 miles

Sept 5, 2017 ~ Day 4: Lake Mývatn and Diamond Circle

Continue drive towards Lake Mývatn. Visits/stops may include Goðafoss (Waterfall of the Gods), Dettifoss (if road is open), Lake Mývatn, Dimmuborgir lava fields, Námaskarð geological fields and Mývatn Nature Baths (entrance fee not included).

Optional activities: Mývatn Nature Baths, Húsavík Whale Museum visit, Sigurgeir's Bird Museum visit.

Overnight in [Fosshóll](#) or similar - [See VIDEO!](#) /near Lake Mývatn

Approximate mileage: 200 miles

Sept 6, 2017 ~ Day 5: Lake Mývatn and Diamond Circle

Continue exploring Lake Mývatn and vicinity. Whatever was not covered on day 4 can be covered on day 5.

Overnight in [Fosshóll](#) or similar - [See VIDEO!](#) /near Lake Mývatn

Approximate mileage: 100–150 miles

Sept 7, 2017 ~ Day 6: The Highlands

Drive across the highlands on Kjölur mountain road. Stops include Hveravellir hot springs area, noteworthy locations in the highlands that have historic interest, areas with beautiful vistas of glaciers and lagoons, and where an opportunity for hiking might be welcomed.

Overnight Hrauneyjar Highlands ~ [Highland Center](#) standard rooms

Approximate mileage: 320 miles (Note! Extra long day!)

Sept 8, 2017 ~ Day 7: The Highlands

Very little driving planned today, if any. Focus on highland excursions that might include areas such as Landmannalaugar, Þjórsárdalur, Veiðivötn, Fjallabak

Optional activities: Heli-flight, super-truck tour, fishing, hiking, fat-tire-biking.

Overnight Hrauneyjar Highlands ~ [Highland Center](#) standard rooms

Sept 9, 2017 ~ Day 8: Transfer to Reykjavík

Drive to Reykjavík. If preferred, we can include a stop at Gjáin, Þjórsárdalur, Gullfoss, Geysir Efstidalur farm (for lunch and/or ice cream; cost not incl) and Þingvellir National Park.

Optional activities: Visit “Þjóðveldisbærinn”, a reconstructed turf farm from the settlement era (entry fee not included), Museum by Geysir.

Overnight in Reykjavík. [Centerhotel Klöpp](#), or similar, standard rooms.

Approximate mileage: 140 miles

Sept 10, 2017 ~ Day 9: Airport Transfer Group will be transferred to Keflavík

International Airport for AM flight.
